It was a privilege to have been invited by Pastor Simpson of the Bible Believers Independent Baptist Church and to have had the opportunity to minister to the people of Cape Coast, Ghana.

Pastor Simpson hosted the "Word of Truth Bible Conference", which was held each evening from 7:00pm until 9:30pm in a local regional hospital parking lot. The parking lot was not only adjacent to the hospital, but also in the midst of a host of villages and other housing developments. The conference started on the evening of March 3rd and continued each evening until March 12th. I had the joy of preaching each night opposite Pastor Simpson, as well as three other men of the church.

In addition to the Bible conference, Pastor Simpson allowed me to preach the Sunday morning church service, which was also a true blessing. We also had the opportunity to preach in the chapel services of two local schools. I also had the opportunity on several occasions to accompany Pastor Simpson on visitation to some special families that he has been ministering to. It was a blessing to see Christ's love so evidently expressed through the Simpson's to the people of Cape Coast.

Whether or not I was a blessing, encouragement or a help to Pastor Simpson, the church at Cape Coast or the people of Cape Coast, I do not know, however I can assure you that they were to me.
